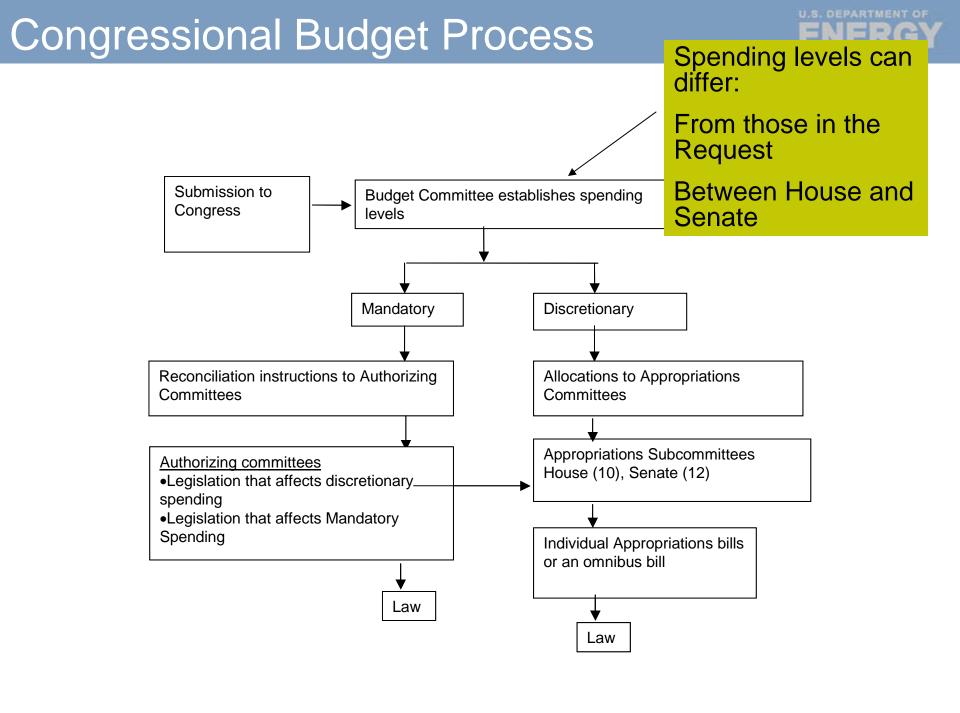

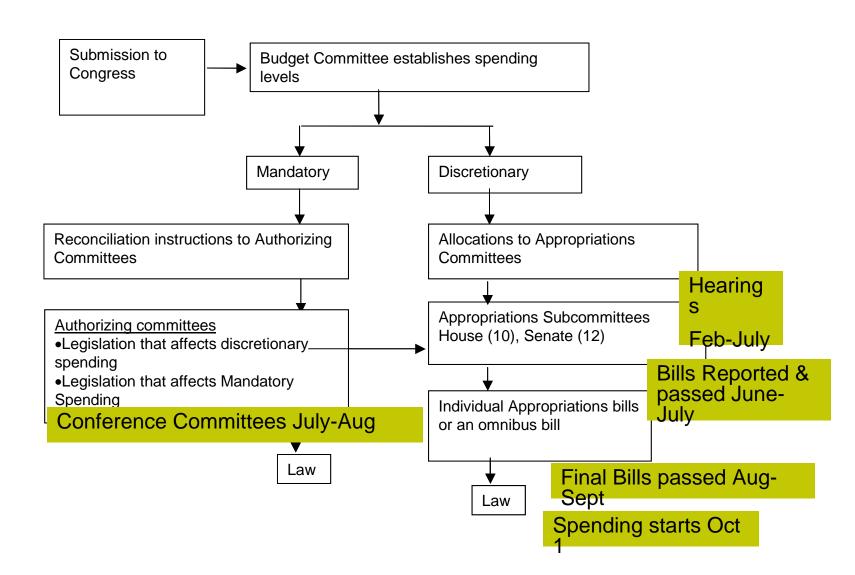

Federal Debt and Deficit



In FY 2009:

- Outlays were \$3.5 T
- Receipts were \$2.1 T
- Deficit was \$1.4 T
- Debt was \$11.9 T

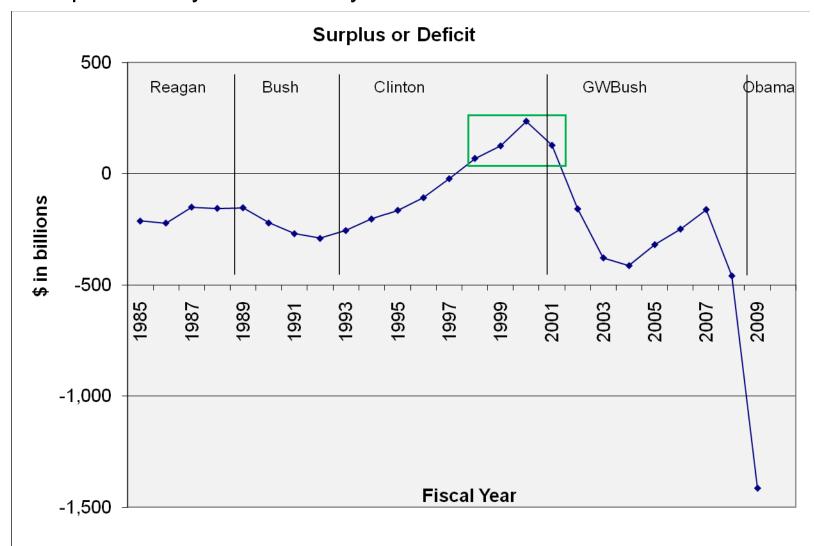
Which means that:

- 40% of the money the U.S. Government spent was borrowed.
- Government debt was 8.4 times amount spent.

Federal Debt and Deficit

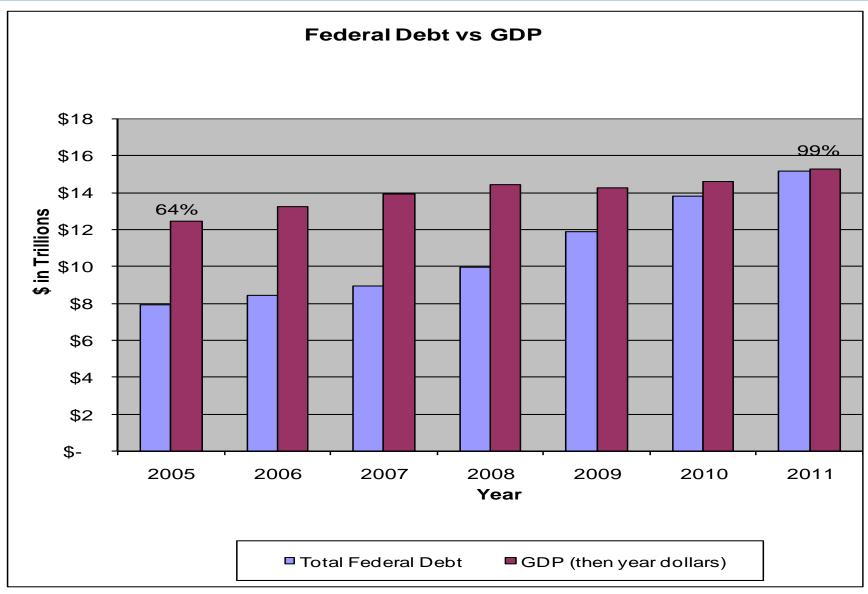


•Surplus in only 4 of last 25 years.
