Observations



- DOE Posture Plan is an excellent document given its defined scope and purpose
- Limitations of the plan:
 - Only addresses the hydrogen and fuel cell program specific to the President's Hydrogen Fuel Initiative – the transportation-related efforts confined to DOE and DOT
 - Plan does not address hydrogen in a broader energy perspective; how it relates to other national energy plans
 - Assumes no policy support, and therefore the Plan's goals, technical targets, and schedules are not reflective of a comprehensive national strategy



Recommendation



- HTAC recommend that the Interagency Task Force be tasked to produce a hydrogen National Action Plan:
 - Reflects the overall policy and priority
 - Covers all Federal department/agency activities
 - Addresses the "limitations" from previous slide
- HTAC should provide support to ITF in this endeavor, including providing information on commercialization barriers for consideration in the planning
