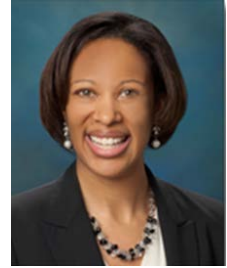


## Janea Scott

Ms. Janea Scott is one of five Commissioners on the California Energy Commission, which is the state's primary energy policy and planning agency. She was appointed by Governor Jerry Brown in February 2013 and reappointed in 2016 and is the lead Commissioner on transportation-related issues. Ms. Scott serves as the Chair of the Western Interconnection Regional Advisory Body and is on the public policy board of Veloz, a nonprofit founded by public and private sector industry veterans to advance the electric car movement. She is also a member of the California Fuel Cell Partnership. Prior to her appointment, Ms. Scott worked at the Department of the Interior in the Office of the Secretary as the Deputy Counselor for Renewable Energy and as the Special Assistant to the Counselor to the Secretary. Before joining the Interior team in April of 2009, Ms. Scott worked on clean air issues as a senior attorney at the Environmental Defense Fund - a non-profit organization that partners with businesses, governments, and communities to find practical environmental solutions. Ms. Scott earned her J.D. from the University of Colorado Boulder Law School and her M.S. and B.S. in Earth Systems from Stanford University.
